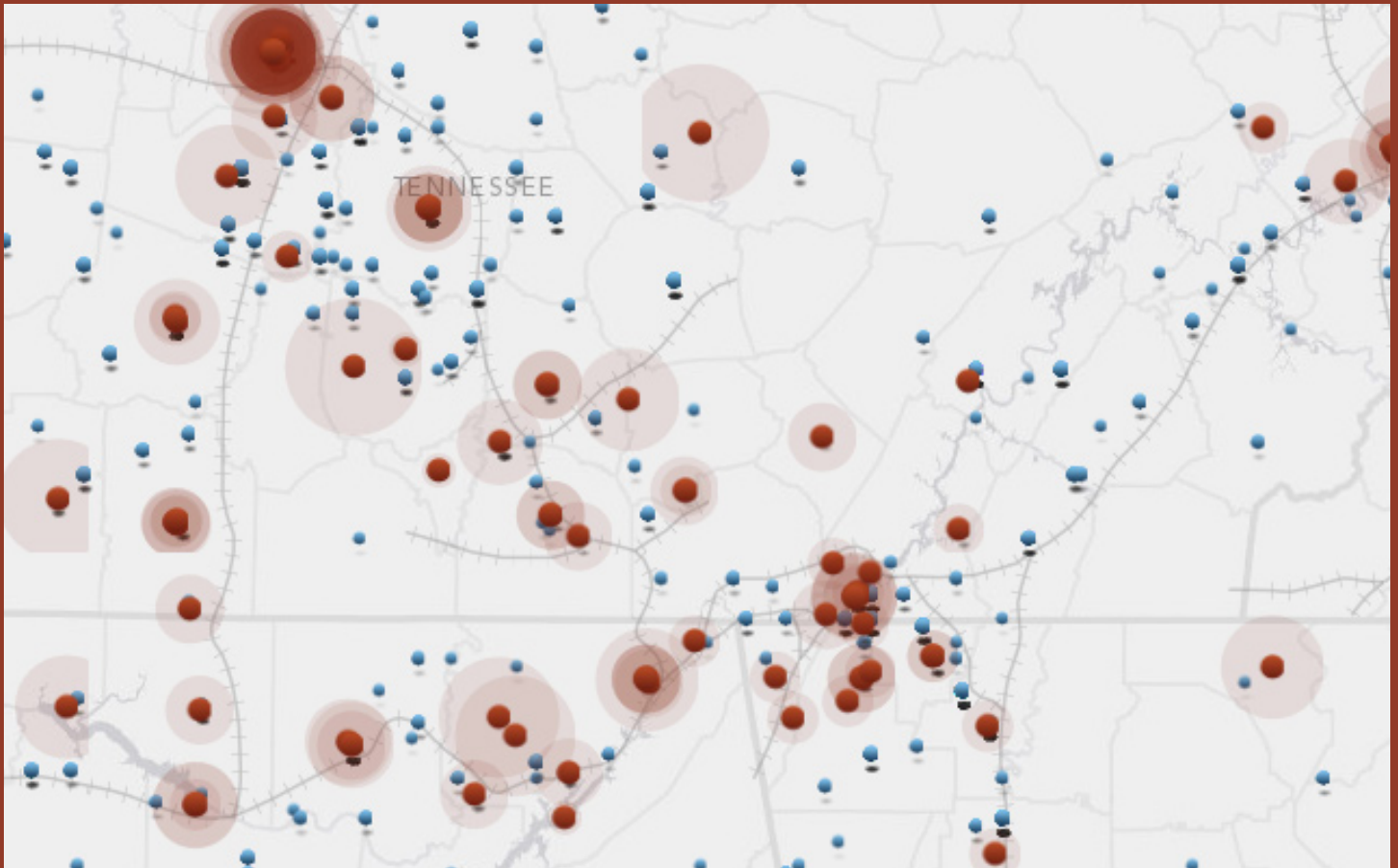


“Geography and the Humanities: Applications of Digital Cartography to Digital Humanities”
